

# City of Martinez Budget & Finance Sub-Committee Meeting Community Groups Grant

## Background

#### Budget for FY24:

- \$12,000 allocated from General Fund
- \$2,500 allocated from Recycle Fund



## **Background Cont'd**

On 03/13, the Budget & Finance Subcommittee recommended:

- Developing an application process to reach more social services providers
- Supplement the program with American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds
- No cap to funding
- Allocate \$85,000 towards the unhoused



## **Background Cont'd**

**Community Group Grant FY24:** 

- Application launched on 03/31
- Promoted via City e-newsletter, website & social media
- Direct outreach to known unhoused providers
- Four-week open period



## **Application Results**

#### **General Fund:**

- 23 applications
- Total funding request: \$282,633.41

#### **Unhoused Requests:**

- 6 applications
- Total funding request: \$167,312.00

#### Recycle Fund:

- 1 application
- Total funding request: \$2,500



### **Budget Considerations**

#### Anticipated ARPA Balance:

- By June 30, 2024 \$1,518,413
- By June 30, 2025 \$1,027,043
- ARPA funds will be needed for other expenses not currently funded through the City's operating budget
- Recommend not using General Fund Unassigned Reserves
- Disciplined approach



## **Next Steps - Committee Recommendations**

- Committee to provide a recommendation to City Council
- Discuss additional allocation of ARPA funds towards the program
- Recommendations for July 19<sup>th</sup> City Council meeting
