# Annual Tree Program Update

Franchise & Public Infrastructure Subcommittee

## Tree City USA Program Requirements

- Maintaining a Tree Board or Department
  - Fulfilled by this Subcommittee
- Having a Community Tree Ordinance
  - Chapter 8.08 of Martinez Municipal Code, Ordinance No. 1450 (December 2023)
- Spending at Least \$2 Per Capita on Urban Forestry
  - Expenses being compiled for both contractor and in-house expenses
  - 2024 total required = 36,439 (latest population figure) x \$2 = \$72,858
- Celebrating Arbor Day
  - Annual Arbor Day Celebration Event coordinated through Recreation on April 27th

### 2024 Recap - Overall Summary (year-to-date)

- Tree Removals: 61
  - 57 removed by staff (primarily behind outfield fence at Hidden Lakes)
  - 4 removed by contractors (Pine and Eucalyptus, for fire fuel reduction and other safety purposes)
  - Tree Plantings: 98
  - Majority of plantings at Pine Meadow Park
  - New plantings also to be done at Hidden Valley Park Pickleball/Tennis Courts
- Tree Prunings: 124
- Tree Budget: \$75,994 (\$53,169 contractor + \$22,825 City in-kind)







# 2024 Recap -Additional Highlights

- Annual Arbor Day Celebration held April 27<sup>th</sup> at Golden Hills Park
- Community volunteers joined staff and Councilmembers; 11 new trees planted!

### Recommendations

- Continue tree plantings at Pine Meadow Park, Hidden Valley Park
  Pickleball/Tennis Courts, Brittany Hills, and Arbor Day Event
- Continue tree replanting program following arborist guidelines and survey results, including medians where trees removed
- Continue arborist evaluations of City parks, open space, and public areas and take action as necessary
- Revisit plan for tree plantings and removals in the Downtown
- Update City Council in December with final 2024 figures
